Highlands Neighborhood Reconstruction

Crews are in the neighborhood working on installing new curb and gutter as well as new concrete aprons. I know the contractor has tagged several houses last Thursday for apron work on Friday. Crews also have tagged houses on Friday for work on Monday. Please understand that these crews are working short-handed and making an exact concrete apron replacement scheduling time impossible to predict. I am doing my best to try to estimate when your apron is going to be replaced, but cannot guarantee the exact date. Crews will be onsite until all apron work that is currently ready has been replaced. If you have been tagged, it will happen either tomorrow or Wednesday. Please remember, I do not coordinate schedules with the subcontractor, and cannot direct their work. Thank you for your understanding to this matter.

I am hoping that possibly this Friday; a large part of the neighborhood will see the first layer of pavement. Coordination with the School District is ongoing to ensure school traffic and bussing go smoothly.

Please do not allow children to draw in the new concrete. This is not just your concrete in front of you home; it belongs to the City and your whole neighborhood. There are several locations around the jobsite where children have signed their names. This is unacceptable to the City, and we will have the contractor remove and replace these pieces. If this keeps up, we will be forced to contact the Edina Police Dept. for assistance.

Doncaster Sidewalk Improvements

- Crews have completed this project. The sod has been placed and is under a 42-day warranty period. Thank you all for making this projects a success!
