The following is the monthly update on the status of the street and utility improvements project in your neighborhood:

A 3-day Memorial Day weekend may give children and adults more time to explore reconstruction sites. Reconstruction sites, machines, and stored materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern. Please remind your children to stay away from Midwest's reconstruction sites, machinery, and stored materials.

Midwest has built a material storage area on Edenmoor Street just north of the intersection (Richwood Dr and Edenmoor St.) There has been silt fence installed on the sides of the staging area. Please stay away from the equipment and road signs in this area!

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of emergency contacts for Midwest.

The utility contractor will start with the watermain and water services on Pinewood Trail first thing next week. Once they are finished on Pinewood, they will begin installing new fire hydrants and fixing sanitary spot repairs.

A few of you have expressed interest in upgrading your sanitary and water services from the main to your house. Please contact me immediately if you are still considering an upgrade. Please note that you will be responsible for hiring your own contractor.
