

**City Extra Update No. 3**  
**Richmond Hills Neighborhood Reconstruction**

During the past week, the contractor has finished the following work in the neighborhood.

- The water main on Pinewood Trail has been installed and is in the process of being tested;
- The sanitary sewer spot repairs have been completed;
- Installation of new gas main in the entire area has completed and new service to homes will follow, with an average of six to seven services installed per day.

During the week of June 2, the contractor will begin or continue the following work in the neighborhood:

- Upgrading the fire hydrants in the entire neighborhood
- The connection of Water services on Pinewood Trail will be finished to the new water main.

The stock pile area is shut down for the remainder of the job. The stock pile is located on Edenmoor Street from the intersection of Richwood Drive and Edenmoor Street to 250' north on Edenmoor Street.

The Contractor has started the upgrades to the fire hydrants in the Neighborhood. The Contractor will notify you a minimum of 24-hrs in advance of the fire hydrant work on your block. You should anticipate periods of no water service during this work.
