Mirror Lakes Neighborhood Reconstruction

CR Fischer, a sub-contractor, has moved into the area to start the concrete work. Curb and gutter will be poured by the end of today on Dundee Road (north, south), and Mirror Lakes Drive from Ayrshire Ave to Dundee Road.

The contractor is getting more done today than expected, as a result, there may be a few concrete aprons poured today. This will only happen with your permission. If your apron is not poured today, the contractor will begin pouring first thing tomorrow. The contractor will hand deliver a flyer to your front door today with instructions regarding where to park your car, and the length of time it will take for the new concrete to cure (7-days). You will not be able to drive over your apron for this length of time. Please watch your front door for this notice.

The asphalt will be removed from Chantrey Road tomorrow, and new concrete curb and gutter will be poured on Monday, August 24.

Next week the crew will begin shaping the gravel roadway surface on Dundee Road and Mirror Lakes Drive, as well as backfilling behind the new curb and gutter.

The contractor has moved back paving the first layer of asphalt on Dundee Road and Mirror Lakes Drive to the middle of next week. This will only be a day of work and you will have access to your driveway by the end of the day.

Please remember this schedule is weather dependent and therefore, can change on a daily basis. As always, please feel free to contact me if you have any questions. Reminder: If you currently have an irrigation system or a pet fence, it may get damaged during construction. If your system is damaged from construction, the contractor has a kit to plug the damaged area so the rest of your irrigation will still work. Once the curb and gutter has been installed, and the black dirt backfilled behind the new curb, you can begin the process of repairing the irrigation systems and pet fences. You will need to contact a company of your liking to fix the damaged area due to construction, and the City of Edina will take care of the bill for you. However, the City will only pay for these repairs on a one time basis. Please have your contractor send the bill directly to the City of Edina.

Please remind all children to stay away from all reconstruction operations, parked equipment, and stockpiled supplies. For everyone's safety, if you see anything onsite that looks out of place or someone that doesn't belong please call the City of Edina Police Department, 952-826-1610. They have been informed of this, and are keeping a close eye on the site for us, but your help would be greatly appreciated if you see anything out of place.
