South Garden Estates Neighborhood Reconstruction

Dear Resident,

The remainder of this week and early next week crews will be onsite doing general site cleanup and taking care of a few outstanding items.

Cured-in-Place Pipe (CIPP) Sanitary Sewer Trunk Pipe Reconstruction:

This week crews will be working on the sanitary sewer main on Andover Road and West Shore Drive, north of Andover Road. This work will temporarily block the flow from your house to the trunk sanitary sewer pipe. Please restrict water usage in your home until the work is complete. Crews will be using a white doorknob hanger/flyer to notify you of the actual date and time the temporary blockage will begin.

Failure to follow the instructions given to you by the contractor could result in a sewer backup. The doorknob hanger will also list emergency contact information if you encounter any difficulties during your particular temporary blockage.

Residents who live at the following addresses on **Andover Road** will be affected by this work:

- **4516, 4517, 4520, 4521, 4524, 4525 and 4529**

Residents who live at the following addresses on **West Shore Drive** will be affected by this work:

- **7000, 7007 and 7008**

Once you have received the notice please pour a gallon of water down every drain in your home. This will fill your plumbing traps with water and prevent odors associated with CIPP work from entering your home through your private sanitary sewer service pipe.

NOTE: During the installation of the liner, your house will be without sanitary sewer service for up to 12 hours.

At this time, crews could be paving the neighborhood as early as this Thursday – weather permitting.

All repair work to irrigation, pet fences, and driveways will be required to be completed in full by September 30, 2009 – NO EXCEPTIONS! Please have the invoices sent in to me at City Hall. Keep in mind only residents with existing working irrigation/pet systems damaged by the reconstruction can send a bill in to have it covered by the City. If you are installing a new system, these expenses will not be reimbursed.
