W. 70th Street (TH100 to France Avenue) Reconstruction Project

Dear Residents:

Please note that this update is divided into two sections. The first section, Phase Updates, contains specific information pertaining to particular residents, while the second section, Overall Updates, contains important information pertaining to all residents.

Phase Updates

Phase 1

(Streets between Cornelia Drive and France Avenue)

Removals

Removal of the existing concrete pavement will commence on April 25. On May 2, Centerpoint will start removing the existing 24" high pressure gas main and preparing to place a new gas main. Centerpoint will be performing gas main replacement between West Shore Drive and France Avenue throughout the month of May and into June.

Utilities

The contractor will begin placing water main near the intersection of Valley View Road and 70th Street. New valves will be placed to limit the need for long water main shut downs. Residents will be notified via doorknob hangers prior to any water main shut-off that will affect your water service. We do not anticipate any water shut-off lasting for more than 4-6 hours.

Overall Updates

Detour

The detour signage will be in place on Friday, April 22; however, 70th Street will not have any barricades in place until Monday, April 25. This will ensure folks who attend Easter at Christ Presbyterian Church will be able to use 70th Street.

As stated in a previous correspondence, W. 70th Street will only be closed to thru traffic but you will still be able to access your home during construction. At some point, complete closure of certain segments of W. 70th Street will take place; however, these closures will only take place during the day and reopen to traffic at night. Attempts will be made to keep complete closures to a minimum and we will do our best to ensure affected residents are notified prior to each closure.

Bus Service

The Metro Transit bus stops and bus routes will be temporarily relocated to 66th Street for the duration of the construction project.

Trash Pickup

Trash pickup during the construction project should be unaffected. 70th Street will be open to traffic in the mornings when garbage trucks are usually doing their pickups. Our inspectors will contact the companies to make sure they are aware they have access.

Safety

Please remind your children to stay away from construction sites, construction machinery, and stockpiled materials. These sites, machines and materials can be dangerous. Job site safety is our number one concern.

Who to Contact in an Emergency

During a life or property-threatening emergency, call 911. If construction equipment or materials need to be moved as part of dealing with the emergency, 911 has a list of the contractor's emergency contacts.

Such activities could be graduation parties, garage sales, retirement parties, weddings, medical deliveries, house moves, etc. The contractor will work with you as best they can to accommodate your event into their reconstruction schedule.
