***Work to be Completed:***

There will be various small and some large items which will be completed over the next few weeks. These items will include curb replacement, bituminous patch replacement, and sod replacement.

***Safety:***

Please drive cautiously when entering and exiting the neighborhood as there will be many construction workers moving throughout the site, as well as moving construction equipment in the streets.

***Water Main Leak Repair:***

There is a leak in the water main located in the rear yard of 4100 Lynn Avenue. The contractor will be on site on Tuesday, May 12, to make the repair. The water main in the rear yard of Lynn Avenue and Monterey Avenue will be shut down. As a result, all homes on Lynn Avenue and Monterey Avenue with an address that begins with 41xx will not have water between 9 am and 4 pm. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. We will be mailing letters to all homes that will be affected by the water main shutdown.

***Project Completion:***

All of the miscellaneous repairs should be wrapped up by the end of May or early June.
